3.1 CINFÃES, HOST TOWN

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The picturesque Portuguese town of Cinfães will be the host of the 2021 edition of the European Mountain Running Championships on Saturday 3 July. Portugal has twice before been the host for this competition, in 2002 and 2015, but both times they were staged on the island of Madeira so this will be the first occasion when the event has been on the mainland of the country. The town itself – which is 350km from the Portuguese capital Lisbon and 80km inland from Porto – has only just over 3000 inhabitants but the surrounding municipality brings the population up to 20,000 with steep mountains on either side of the nearby River Douro.

4. TRAVEL TO CINFÃES

The official airport for the European Mountain Running Championships 2021 is Porto Airport (OPO), located about 80 km from Cinfães, where the LOC will provide adequate welcome services.

Upon arrival at Porto Airport, the teams will be met by LOC representatives. The Welcome Desk shall be situated at the Porto Airport arrivals terminal and will be open from Tuesday 29 June, depending on travel schedules. If members of the participating Federations are planning to arrive

earlier they will have to contact the LOC well in advance to make sure specific arrangements are made.

After collecting luggage, team members will be escorted to the official buses by the Welcome Desk staff and taken to the teams' hotels, approximately 70 to 80 minutes from Porto Airport, depending on the traffic conditions.

There will be no Welcome Desk neither at the main railway station in Porto nor at Mosteiro/Caldas

5. VISA INFORMATION

Participants from the following countries require a visa to enter Portugal:

ARM – AZE – BLR – KOS* – RUS – TUR

*As defined by United Nations Security Council Resolution 1244 of 10 June 1999.

The following nationalities are exempt from holding a visa to enter Portugal:

ALB* - BIH* - MKD* - MDA* - MNE* - SRB** - UKR*

*The exemption shall apply only to holders of biometric passports.

**Excluding holders of Serbian passports issued by the Serbian Coordination Directorate (Koordinaciona uprava).

It is the Member Federations own responsibility to apply for Visas in due time before leaving their country, from the Portuguese Embassy or Consulate, and to make sure that all the documents required for the application are complete. Incomplete applications slow down the process and may lead to a visa not being issued on time.

Participants who require a visa should send all relevant details (as listed below) by 1 June 2021 to obtain a special invitation letter and visa application information. Due to the current pandemic, it is crucial that relevant information is received by the above-mentioned deadline as otherwise entry to Portugal cannot be guaranteed.

Aregos station. Teams arriving by train will be met by LOC representatives and taken to the teams' hotels, according to the arrival times given in the final entry system.

Teams arriving by car are kindly requested to go directly to their hotels where representatives from the LOC will welcome them.

Transportation between the teams' hotels and the various venues, including official and social functions, will be guaranteed by the LOC.

The European Athletics Entries System is accessible at 1102.5. the following link: https://evententry.worldathletics.org. Member Federations' entries manager shall use their already known individual and personalised access.

In order to limit the risks, we would like to point out that participation of all non-essential categories is being limited. We are requesting the Member Federations to contribute to the general efforts to make possible this event to take place by not registering any out-of-ratio officials or personal coaches. The Member Federations are thus requested to take it into consideration while making their Preliminary Entries, to open on 16 March 2021.

Furthermore, in case your Member Federation's President and/or General Secretary/CEO are planning on attending the event, we remind you that they will be required to be accredited either as a team member (and therefore entered into the final entries), or as a VIP (and therefore registered through the LOC/pedro.semblano@cm-cinfaes.pt with copy to European Athletics/daniel.pereira@european-athletics.org).

The 2021 edition of the European Mountain Running Championships will be staged on an uphill and downhill course whose programme shall comprise events for Men and Women and for Under 20 Men and Women.

In accordance with European Athletics competition regulations:

1102.3.

The European Mountain Running Championships comprises separate events for teams and individuals representing European Athletics Member Federations.

Athletes entered in the European Mountain Running Championships may participate as individuals and as members of teams representing European Athletics Member Federations.

1102.6.

Each European Athletics Member Federation may enter a maximum of 6 (six) athletes of which a maximum of 4 (four) may participate.

1102.7.

No athlete aged less than 16 (sixteen) years on 31 December of the year of the competition may participate in the European Mountain Running Championships and no athlete aged less than 18 (eighteen) years on 31 December of the year of the competition may participate in the Senior races.

I Run Clean certification

Each European Athletics Member Federation may enter only those athletes who have received and hold a valid certification for having completed the European Athletics Anti-Doping Education Programme - I Run Clean.

8. FINANCIAL CONDITIONS

According to point 1110.4. of the European Mountain for a maximum of 3 (three) male and 3 (three) female Running Championships competition regulations, European Athletics shall bear the board and lodging expenses of visiting teams at the venue of the competition for a maximum period of not more than 3 (three) days and

athletes in each category.

No contribution shall be made in respect of teams representing the host EA Member Federation.

Ratio of Athletes and Officials

The number of team officials in the hereunder chart is also eligible for fixed price accommodation and other benefits; however, European Athletics will not cover these officials' accommodation costs:

Team Officials include: Head of Delegation, Team Leaders, Coaches, Medical Staff (medical doctors and physiotherapists), Team Press Liaison and others.

(1) The number of above mentioned team officials is eligible for fixed price accommodation and other benefits.

Accommodation Costs

The following rates (by room) must be paid by the Member Federations for team members above the previously mentioned quota:

All prices include meals and VAT

(1) For the official period, each team shall be allocated a minimum number of single rooms equivalent to 10% of the total number of athletes and in ratio team officials entered in the final entries, at the price of a twin room in single occupancy (75 EUR). Additional single rooms can be requested and will be given according to availability. The price for the additional single room is 100 EUR.

(2) In case of later arrival/early departure of the sharing person, the night the twin room is used as a single room will be charged at the rate of the twin room in single occupancy (75 EUR).

The official period (for which European Athletics is covering team accommodation and board) is from Thursday 1 July to Sunday 4 July (3 nights), while the additional period has been fixed for 2 nights (29 and 30 June) before the official period. If your team is planning to stay outside this period, the above-mentioned rates will not apply, and a separate agreement will have to be made with the LOC: pedro.semblano@cm-cinfaes.pt

According to the competition regulations (1110.9) European Athletics Member Federations are responsible for taking out their own insurance to cover illness or injury to any member of their party when travelling to and from and during the European Mountain Running Championships 2021.
